Introduction



Alzheimer's Pakistan is the leading national organization dedicated to improving the lives of individuals affected by Alzheimer's disease and related dementias. Registered with the Punjab Social Welfare Department, the organization's primary mission is to enhance the quality of life for individuals living with dementia and provide comprehensive support to their caregivers.

Since its inception in 1999, Alzheimer's Pakistan has played a crucial role in increasing public awareness about dementia. The organization has developed a wide range of essential services including day care centers, memory clinics, support groups, and training programs aimed at families, healthcare professionals, and social workers. With a volunteer-driven model, Alzheimer's Pakistan brings together individuals from diverse fields, all united by a shared commitment to the cause. The organization is also supported by charitable donations, which are tax-exempt under Section 2(36) of the Income Tax Ordinance 2001.

With its growing network of branches across Pakistan, Alzheimer's Pakistan continues to expand its services. On September 1, 2024, the Gujranwala branch was inaugurated, furthering the organization's mission to raise awareness and provide comprehensive care to individuals affected by Alzheimer's disease in the region. This new branch serves as a hub for advocacy, memory care services, and counseling, with a special focus on supporting individuals with dementia and their families.

The establishment of the Gujranwala branch was made possible through collaboration with Ali Warraich, the founder of the Alzheimer's & Dementia Care Bridge. Alzheimer's Pakistan Gujranwala has made significant strides in raising awareness through educational programs and advocacy initiatives in schools and communities across Gujranwala.



United for Dementia Care

A Joint Initiative in Gujranwala

This past year has marked another important chapter in the ongoing collaboration between Alzheimer's Pakistan and Alzheimer's & Dementia Care Bridge (ADCB) in Gujranwala. Building on the foundation laid over the past two years, our shared mission continues to focus on bridging critical gaps in dementia care access, education, and support for families living in underserved communities of Punjab.

Sustaining Grassroots Advocacy and Education

In rural Gujranwala, where literacy rates among adults remain low and awareness of Alzheimer's and dementia is minimal, our biweekly educational sessions have continued uninterrupted throughout the year. These sessions are led by a growing team of local educators – primarily teachers from lower and primary schools – who have volunteered their time and skills to sustain this community-driven model. Their efforts are transforming local schools and community centers into hubs of knowledge, providing families with practical guidance on recognizing dementia symptoms, delivering daily care, and combating stigma surrounding cognitive decline.

Through these grassroots programs, we have continued to empower caregivers, reaching hundreds of families across multiple villages. This work not only fills an information void but also fosters a culture of understanding and compassion, ensuring that patients are no longer hidden or dismissed due to misconceptions about dementia.

Strengthening Networks and Partnerships

The Gujranwala branch's success has been made possible through continued collaboration between Alzheimer's Pakistan and ADCB. Alzheimer's Pakistan representatives have played a key role in building local health networks using the infrastructure available in Gujranwala, while ADCB has worked on the ground to connect rural families with these newly forming support structures. This dual approach is creating a sustainable framework for care, ensuring that resources – whether medical consultations, counseling, or educational materials – are more readily available to communities that previously had no access to such support.

Together, we are laying the foundation for a more integrated system of dementia care in Gujranwala, one



Expanding Impact: From Rural to Semi-Urban Areas

While our primary focus has remained on rural villages, where the need is most acute, this past year has seen growing demand for similar initiatives in semi-urban parts of Gujranwala. Families in these areas often face unique challenges: while basic literacy and healthcare access are higher than in the villages, stigma and lack of practical caregiving knowledge persist. Looking ahead, ADCB plans to gradually expand outreach into these semi-urban neighborhoods and ultimately into more urban areas as well, leveraging our volunteer-led education model while collaborating with local organizations and Alzheimer's Pakistan to extend dementia-friendly resources into new communities.

Looking Forward

The establishment of the Gujranwala branch as part of Alzheimer's Pakistan marked a significant milestone in 2024. Today, the focus is on consolidation and sustainable growth:

- Continuing biweekly sessions led by dedicated schoolteachers and local volunteers.
- Expanding the pool of trained educators and community advocates to reach more families.
- Strengthening partnerships with Alzheimer's Pakistan to enhance resource distribution, family counseling, and long-term support networks.
- Exploring the next phase of expansion into semi-urban areas, ensuring continuity of our grassroots model while adapting to new settings.

Through these efforts, our mission remains steadfast: no individual or family in Gujranwala should navigate dementia alone. Together with Alzheimer's Pakistan, we are building not only awareness but also lasting infrastructure for dementia care in a region where it has long been overlooked.

Staff Training

The training plan for newly hired employee at Alzheimer Pakistan spanned over two weeks at the Lahore head office, designed to equip caregivers with essential skills and knowledge to support patients and their families.

- Focused on patient observation and rapport building through facility tours and shadowing experienced caregivers.
- Engagement in dementia awareness sessions to develop a strong understanding of the condition.
- Empathy and active listening skills.
- Caregiving education and support strategies.
- Stress management and conflict resolution techniques to help caregivers manage both patient and family stress.
- Future planning and cognitive activities to enhance patient well-being.
- Practical counseling sessions with peer feedback and progress evaluations.
- Awareness raising skills.


